Statement of Case

In respect of proposed 18 wind turbines, 125m high, at Middle Moor, Alnwick

The council is aware of the widespread opposition to this development and supports the campaign S.A.N.E (Save Northumberland's Environment).

The Council will object on the following grounds;

The size and position of the turbines will have a massive detrimental impact on the landscape as seen from miles around.

Change to unspoilt views from the heritage coastline, and Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty;

Harm to the amenity of the natural environment;

Harm to the setting of the Historic parks and Castles;

Detrimental effect on tourism and the harm to the local economy;

The damage done to such a vulnerable sensitive historic landscape outweighs any claimed saving in CO2 emissions;

We request that the inspector does not allow this development.
